Scarborough Athletic Football Club Safeguarding Strategy

- Scarborough Athletic Football Club (SAFC) to recruit a Club Welfare Officer (CWO) in line with guidance published by the FA. The CWO to be in this post for the start of the 2017/18 season.
- The CWO will be expected to adhere to FA guidance with respect to the specific roles and responsibilities and to complete the FA Safeguarding Children course and Welfare Officer Workshop. Furthermore, the CWO must have a current FA Criminal Records Check (CRC).
- SAFC to develop a Safeguarding website.
- The CWO will ensure that Safeguarding Policy and Procedures on behalf of SAFC are
 published on the SAFC Website and in line with Policy and Procedures issued by the FA.
 Additionally, information relating to reporting safeguarding incidents to be clear and
 visible on the SAFC Safeguarding Website.
- The CWO will work closely with the SAFC Junior Secretary, Youth Development Officer, Managers and Coaches in all matters relating to children's activities with and on behalf of SAFC.
- SAFC to nominate a representative from the Board and take responsibility for liaising with Junior Football Managers, Coaches and CWO and attend meetings approximately every 8 weeks.
- The SAFC Board of Directors, Junior representative, Head of Youth Development and CWO to contribute in developing a Club Action Plan (Safeguarding).
